CBSE is conducting the Secondary and Senior Secondary Board Examinations 2026 for the students of more than 31,000 schools affiliated to it in India and 26 countries abroad from 17th February 2026 to 10th April 2026. There are about 46 lakh students, who would be appearing in these examinations from more than 8074 examination centres across the country and abroad.

CBSE introduces several innovative measures for Examinations every year and in the year 2026, the Board has introduced 03 important initiatives as per the following details:

1. Second Board Examinations in Class X
2. On – Screen Marking for Class XII
3. Division of Question Paper in In Subjects Science and Social Studies for Class X

Conducting Examinations at such a large scale requires foolproof planning and successful execution at the examination and the evaluation centers Therefore, it becomes essential to communicate the amended policies and innovative measures introduced, with all the functionaries involved during the Examinations and evaluation.

Accordingly, the Board has decided to organize a Live Webcast to explain the Guidelines for the conduct of Examinations and On Screen Marking as per the following schedule:-



- (a) You will require a screen, sound system, and Internet connection to view the Webcast.
- (b) All schools will compulsorily make arrangements to watch the Live Webcast under the Supervision of the Principal
- (c) All teachers teaching Classes IX to Classes-XII and other staff involved in the conduct of examination and evaluation should watch the webcast and note down important instructions pertaining to their role in the examination.
- (d) As Guidelines for the CS have already been sent to all the examination centres, hence, query, if any, may please be sent to CBSE on e-mail id [info.cbseexam@cbseeducation.in](mailto:info.cbseexam@cbseeducation.in) so that these queries can be taken up during the course of the webcast.
- (e) Queries (if any ) after the webcast may also be sent on the above-mentioned email id so that these queries can be addressed.
- (f) RDs/ROs along with their officers/officials shall attend the Webinar.
- (g) Each school is required to upload the following on ASAR app which can be downloaded from Google Play Store:-
  - i. A geotagged photograph covering the participants
  - ii. Total number of participants in the program

The Live Webcast will begin with the keynote address of Sh. Rahul Singh (IAS), Chairperson, CBSE. I am sure that these two hours will equip us well for the upcoming CBSE Board Examinations 2026. Hence, all schools are requested to join as per the schedule mentioned.
